

**Guidelines for epckIDS.** Please follow these guidelines, and also understand that some of these things will change along the way.

epckIDS	Start and finish	Before you come	COVID measures
<p>This term the children will be learning about living for Jesus from some of the letters in the New Testament</p> <p>The kids' talk in the service will be on the topic that the kids are learning about</p> <p>The program will be targeted at ages 4-8. If your child is outside those ages but you would like them to be involved they are most welcome. Please discuss with Tom Wyatt or another epckIDS leader</p>	<p>Try to arrive a little early (about 9:15)</p> <p>Sign your child in to the epckIDS program at the door when you arrive at church</p> <p>Children will be seated with their parents in church until after the kids' talk</p> <p>After the kids' talk, participating children will be invited to leave with leaders through the back of the hall</p> <p>After the service finishes parents will collect their children from the undercover area</p>	<p>Stay home if you're sick or if you've been in recent contact with someone who was in a COVID hotspot</p> <p>If you have COVID symptoms, stay home and call your doctor to request a test. Symptoms include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Fever</li><li>- Coughing</li><li>- Sore throat</li><li>- Shortness of breath</li></ul> <p>If someone in your house is a bit crook, you may still be able to come to church. But if there's a chance they have COVID then you should all isolate until they get the results of their test</p>	<p>Children will be encouraged to keep a distance of 1.5m from one another to the extent possible</p> <p>Tables and chairs will be cleaned by leaders before and after use</p> <p>There will be a maximum of 4 people seated at any one table</p> <p>Activities will not involve hand-holding or food</p>
